

# The Japan-US Science Forum in Boston

## Call for Poster Presentations

We invite you to submit a poster to be displayed at the forum.

### Subject Areas

All research areas (natural sciences, social sciences, engineering and humanities) related to “rapidly aging society,” such as health; population research; public administration; agriculture; Japanese studies; IT; robotics; A.I., etc.

### Eligibility and Requirements

Applicants (a corresponding author in case of work by a collaboration) must be affiliated to academic and/or research institutions.

During poster session, applicants must stand in front of the poster and explain their poster to audience and are expected to attend all other session.

### Application Submission Guidelines

The poster previously displayed at open events, such as academic conferences and/or workshops, will be accepted; however, you are responsible for any copyright infringement.

Submission process is as follows:

#### (1) Complete the application form

Please complete [the application form](#) no later than **5 pm EST on Friday, September 30, 2016**. Applications submitted via e-mail will not be accepted.

In the application form, applicants are required to provide abstract describing the poster (250 words maximum).

Applicant’s name, current title and affiliation, field of specialization and poster title will be published in the forum booklet.

## **(2) Submit the poster**

After completing the application form, applicants have two options to submit the poster:

- (a) Applicants who wish JSPS Washington Office to print the poster, submit PDF data of the poster by Friday, September 30, 2016 via e-mail at [symposium@jpspsusa.org](mailto:symposium@jpspsusa.org).
- (b) After September 30, 2016, applicants must print the poster and bring them to the forum by themselves.

## **Poster Format Descriptions**

- Should be written in English.
- Should not exceed 3 feet high x 4 feet wide.
- Title, names of presenter and organization should appear on top.
- The poster will be subject to approval by JSPS Washington Office.

## **Poster Awards**

Awards will be given to remarkable presentations.

## **Financial Support**

JSPS Washington Office will support accommodation based on its stipulation, \$141, to those who require overnight stay.

Those who request to receive financial support will be notified of the acceptance (or rejection) of their request within 3 business days after he/she submit the application form.
